ENTRANT DERBY RULES

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE IDAHO FISH AND GAME AND THE CDA TRIBAL RULES & REGULATIONS. Any Angler receiving a fishing citation while participating in the Big One Derby is automatically withdrawn as a derby entrant from this derby. All other fishermen in the boat are also disqualified.

All participants further agree to abide by the rules set forth by the Big One Derby Committee. Any disputes regarding eligibility or legality of fish or an angler, will be decided by the derby committee and all decisions are final. A polygraph test may be required.

EVERY LICENSED IDAHO ANGLER IN THE BOAT MUST HAVE A DERBY TICKET. DERBY TICKETS CAN BE PURCHASED AT FINS AND FEATHERS TACKLE SHOP, BLACK SHEEP SPORTING GOODS & NORTH 40 CDA, & ELEPHANT BOYS.

Participants must register themselves prior to fishing. The registration form must be signed by the angler and in the anglers possession when entering a fish into the derby.

Youth 13 years old and under must register themselves, at no cost, prior to fishing. They may register as an adult and be eligible for adult prizes only.

A registered angler may enter two fish per day. Fish must be weighed in on the same day caught. All fish must be weighed in at one of the designated weigh stations, Sun Up Bay Marina on the south end or Carlin Bay Resort mid lake or Fins and Feathers Tackle Shop & Guide Service.

The fish must remain intact with entrails, taken to a derby weigh station, weighed and measured on the day it was caught. After fish have been recorded for weight, length and photographed, they can remain with the fisherman.

If your fish is in the top 3, it must be taken to Fins and Feathers Tackle Shop within 48 hours to be held on display until the derby banquet. You will need to pick up your fish at Fins & Feathers and bring it to the derby banquet on August 9th at the Eagles Event Park on 15th Street for viewing.

The only fish eligible in the adult category are Chinook Salmon 30" or larger, children's division Chinook Salmon 24" or larger, caught in Lake Coeur d'Alene and limited by IDFG & CDA Tribal regulations.

Chinook Salmon must be caught in Lake Coeur d'Alene ONLY. Lateral waters (tributaries and the chain lakes) ARE NOT INCLUDED. The designated boundaries of Lake Coeur d'Alene for the purpose of this derby are:

NORTHWEST: The pilings standing in the water at the mouth of the Spokane River, stay on the lake side of the pilings.

EAST: The highway bridge as it crosses over the eastern tip of Wolf Lodge Bay and the Highway 97 bridge over the Coeur d'Alene River near Harrison, stay on the lake side of the bridges.

SOUTH: The railroad trestle south of Conklin Park, stay north of the trestle. Do not go under the trestle into the Chatcolet Lake.

THESE BOUNDARIES WILL BE OBSERVED BY THE DERBY RULES COMMITTEE VIA PRIVATE BOATS AND WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

GOOD LUCK TO ALL OF THE ANGLERS AND BE SAFE!

BOATING SAFETY LAWS ARE MANDATORY: LIFE JACKETS FOR EVERY PERSON ABOARD YOUR BOAT, LICENSE AND REGISTRATION, FLAG, HORN, PADDLE, FLOAT PAD, NAV LIGHTS REQUIRED IN THE EARLY MORNING AND LATE EVENING.

LAKE ETIQUETTE: LEAVE PLENTY OF ROOM BETWEEN BOATS ESPECIALLY WHEN BRINGING IN A FISH. DO NOT TAILGATE. LEAVE AT LEAST 200 FEET FROM BOATS AND DOCKS WHEN TROLLING. WHEN UNDERWAY AND ON PLANE, LEAVE 300 FEET BETWEEN DOCKS AND BOATS THAT ARE UNDER TROLL.

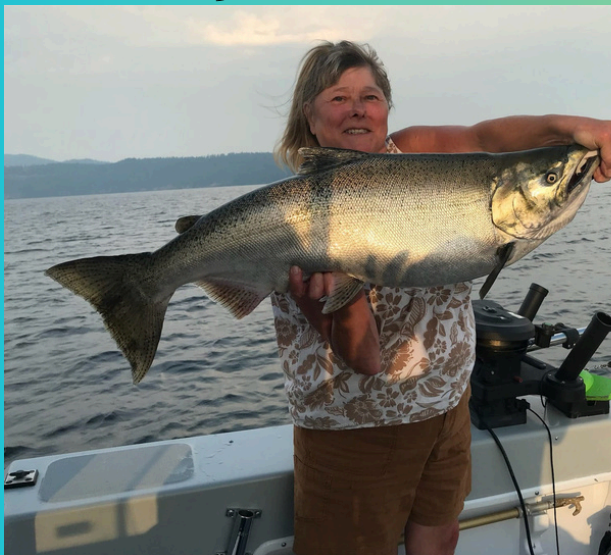

Don Houk's Rule of Thumb



These combinations have worked consistently over the years for Lake Coeur d'Alene chinook salmon. When I'm running a fly or hoochie in combination with either a flasher /dodger, I'll use a 20# leader. On herring and flasher/dodger combinations, I'll use a 15 # leader.

There are no set rules with any of these setups. At times, speeding up or slowing down may help. Maybe a little longer or shorter leader is needed. Your setup may work better 100 feet behind the downrigger ball rather than 30 feet. Sometimes the slightest change in your presentation will be enough to trigger a strike. Good luck to you!

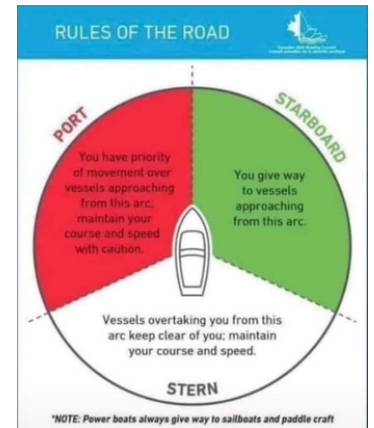

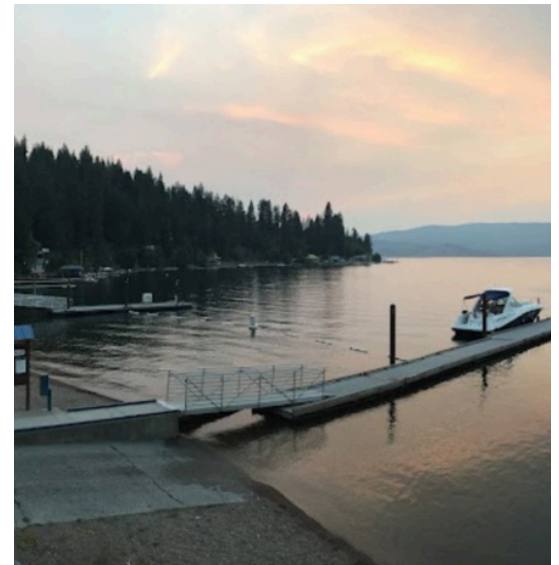

Know the Boating Rules

BASIC RULES

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any type of vessel or watercraft on the public waters within Kootenai County, Idaho in a negligent manner. IDAHO law requires that any operator of a vessel involved in an accident or collision, report the accident or collision to the Sheriff's Department immediately; provided that property damage exceeds \$1500.00 or there is death or personal injury or persons missing.

Children age fourteen and under must wear an approved life jacket when they are aboard a vessel 19 feet long or less when the vessel is underway or under power. This applies to manually propelled boats as well as motorboats.

SPEED RESTRICTIONS

Speed limits for all public waterways except the Coeur d'Alene and Spokane Rivers, and Lower Twin Lakes are as follows:

- ♦ **5 MPH, a NO WAKE ZONE**, within (200') two hundred feet of shoreline or any dock, pier, breakwater, or any person in the water.
- ♦ **50 MPH** during daylight hours
- ♦ **15 MPH**, or less, within (100') one hundred feet of any other vessel.
- ♦ **20 MPH**, or less, at night unless otherwise restricted.

Speed limits for Coeur d'Alene River, the Spokane River, and Lower Twin Lakes are as follows:

- ♦ **5 MPH, NO WAKE ZONE**, within one hundred feet (100') of shoreline, dock, pier, breakwater, or person in the water, and
- ♦ **35 MPH**, or less, during the day, unless regulated otherwise.
- ♦ **15MPH** within 50' of another vessel
- ♦ **20 MPH**, or less, at night.

Personal Watercraft, canoes, kayaks, and inflatables are subject to boating laws and ordinances.

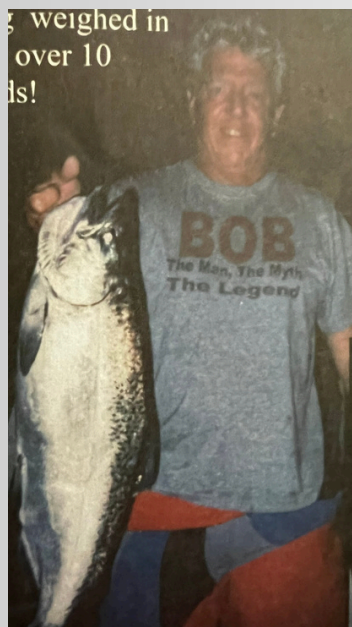

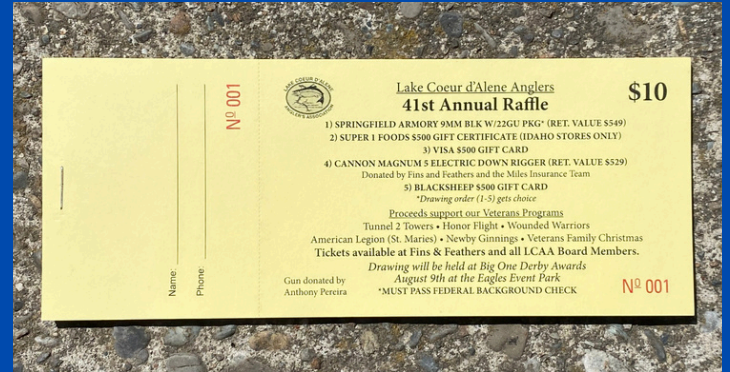

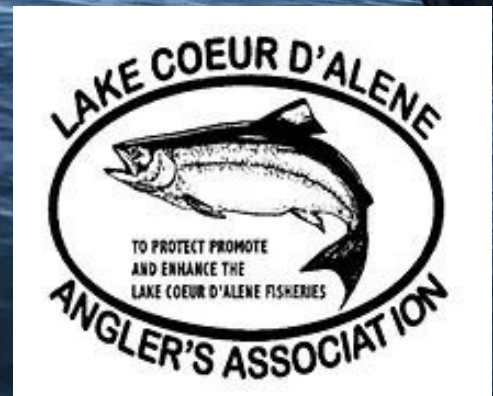
